Students should also be responsible to clean up their area in the gym after games where candy wrappers and spilled popcorn gets left.

Old Business:

- Backpack fundraiser- All backpacks are in except 2. There was a discount for the faulty embroidery. Some people were willing to donate the extra money they paid and some took the \$35 discount. If we plan on doing the backpack fundraiser again we should look at getting that going now, as it took a long time to organize and order.
- Activity Center Cleaning Update- Tiffany has been cleaning the activity center and locker rooms. Mr. Wardyn has been supportive. Looking at getting some new cleaning products. Many of ours are outdated and lose their effectiveness. The boys Jr. High locker room needs updating. The weight room floor needs cleaning. Tiffany reached out to Nate Strehle on how to properly clean that type of floor mats.
- Improvements needed Activity Center- suggestions include painting the lobby, epoxying the locker room floors. Should do a walk through with Mike and Josh to make a list of things needed to be updated/repaired.
- Popcorn machine- at the football field every 3rd batch trips the breaker. Chris K. will look at fixing it. We didn't have popcorn at all at the last home game.
- Prime rib fundraiser- Organized by Jay Kreikemeier. Will do prime rib raffles Dec. 1-15. They will do two home boy/girl games and one wrestling meet.
- Clear bag fundraiser- Will go ahead and order about 50 clear bags with Bluejay logo and sell them at basketball games and wrestling meets.

New Business

- Fine Arts Raffle Fundraiser- You may have seen something on facebook. Organized by Renee Eames and Charissa Steffensmeier. The Booster Club will buy some items to get them started on the raffle till they get going and can be self-sufficient.
- Yard signs- Booster club will buy signs for boys basketball coaches and speech coaches as they don't already have one. They are \$16 each.
- 125 Dinner- the date on the school calendar (Jan. 23, 2024) won't work as the Neilson center is already booked for something else. Will look at moving the date.
- Venmo account- Booster club has set up a Venmo account. We were unable to set it up as a non-profit so there would be a 1.5-2% fee for using it.
